1. Ingredient name

Glimepiride

2. What this medication is used for

(Hypoglycemic agent)

Treats type II diabetes by promoting insulin secretion.

3. How to take this medication

Take before meals.

May cause drowsiness, dizziness, and headache. Be cautious if you intend to drive a car or operate machinery.

Avoid drinking alcohol, as it may enhance the hypoglycemic effect, therefore, cause hypoglycemic coma.

If you experience any symptoms of hypoglycemia such as sudden hunger, vertigo, or shivering, eat a piece of candy, drink some fruit juice, etc.

Make sure to inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicine if you are sensitive to sulfonamides.
