2. What this medication is used for

(Antipyretic/analgesic/anti-inflammatory agent)

A non-steroid analgesic/anti-inflammatory agent that treats fever, pain, and inflammation.

3. How to take this medication

May cause gastrointestinal disorders. Take with food.

Avoid drinking alcohol, as it may cause gastrointestinal bleeding.

May raise the blood pressure, therefore, inhibit the efficacy of antihypertensive agents.

If you are pregnant or may be pregnant, inform your doctor or pharmacist before taking this medicine.

In rare cases, you may have reductions in urine, black stool, or allergic reactions (itching, swelling in the face and hands, breathlessness, or chest pain). Immediately inform your doctor or pharmacist if you experience these symptoms.
