1. Ingredient name

Rabeprazole

2. What this medication is used for

(Anti-peptic ulcer agent)

Treats gastrointestinal tract disorders by reducing gastric acid secretion.

3. How to take this medication

Take with water before meals. Do not chew or crush.

May cause headache, drowsiness, or dizziness.

May cause diarrhea, constipation, nausea, vomiting, or abdominal distention.

Avoid coffee, alcohol and smoking, as they may increase gastric acid secretion.

Prolonged use of this medication may cause bone fracture, atrophic gastritis, or diarrhea. Be aware of these symptoms.
