

Medication Information for English Speakers

1. Ingredient name

Vildagliptin

2. What this medication is used for

(Oral hypoglycemic agent)

Treats type II diabetes by promoting insulin production and inhibiting glucagon production.

3. How to take this medication

Take at the same time each day, regardless of your mealtime.

Avoid drinking alcohol, as it may trigger and sustain the hypoglycemic action of this medication.

Liver function tests may be required. Be aware of symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, fatigue, dark urine color, and jaundice.

If you experience any symptoms of hypoglycemia such as sudden hunger, vertigo, or shivering, eat a piece of candy, drink some fruit juice, etc.

In rare cases, you may have severe pain in the abdomen or back. Immediately inform your doctor or pharmacist if you experience such symptoms.
